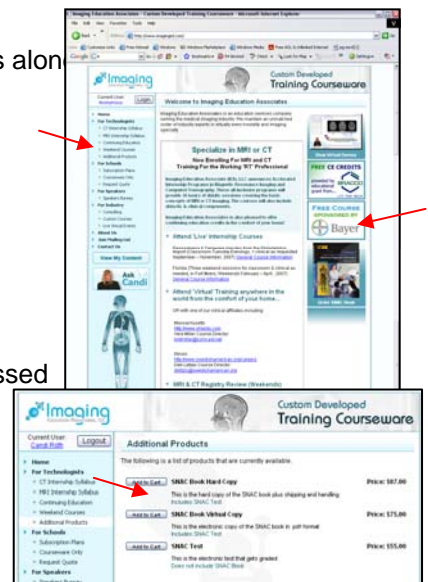

SNAC Book Information:

This book has been designed as a “written” version of a live lecture.

When it was first published, the SNAC book (including the 400+ question multiple choice post test) was accredited by the ASRT, and approved for 20 Category “A” credits. At that time the post tests were graded by hand, credits were processed and certificates of completion were mailed by snail mail. Since that time, the technology and the internet, have made it more efficient to do these processes on-line. ***These tests have not been graded by hand since 2005.***

Regarding the credits, the book **WAS** originally accredited for 20 category “A” credits, by the ASRT, and remained that way until December 2007. After that, credits have been reduced, based on the ASRT’s new regulations. Credit renewal for this book, was submitted October 2007. *Regarding the new credit regulations... It used to be that credits were provided for the “time” it takes to do the module (read the book) plus+ the time it takes to take the multiple choice post test. In this case if it takes approximately 1 hour to read the book plus 30 minutes to take the post test, the self study module would be worth 1.5 credits.*

As of January 2006, the rules changed. According to the new rules, the credits are calculated whereby only the “time” it takes to do the module (read the book) *counts* for credits. The time it takes to complete the post test does not count any longer. *So in the above mentioned example: One hour to read the book and 30 minutes to take the test, we only get 1.0 credit for that module.*
